Course Content:

This 90 min webinar aims at providing up to date insight on common CR symptoms sighted at emergency setting, such as hernia and hemorrhoids.

On one hand, this course seeks to equip emergency medicine specialists on the first line response of such symptoms, on the other, it also serves as an knowledge update to CR surgeons on how to treat such symptoms in a non-elective, emergency setting with emphasis on common issues like bleeding and wound management.

Objectives:

1. To Facilitate interdisciplinary discussion between emergency physicians and colorectal surgeons on critical cases encountered in emergency settings.
2. To Address intraoperative and postoperative bleeding complications and discuss best-practice strategies for surgical intervention.
3. To Provide an evidence-based educational platform focused on decision-making in emergency colorectal procedures.

Topic 1: Management of Groin Hernias in Emergency Settings

Overview:

Groin hernias are frequently encountered in emergency departments and often require urgent surgical intervention. This session will address:

1. Indications for emergency surgical repair and criteria for referral to colorectal surgery.
2. Comparison of laparoscopic versus open approaches, including technical considerations, patient outcomes, and complication rates.
3. Strategies for intraoperative hemorrhage control in emergency hernia repair.

Key Focus: Bleeding management in laparoscopic and open hernia repair.

Topic 2: Emergency Treatment of Bleeding Hemorrhoids

Overview:

Acute hemorrhoidal bleeding can present significant challenges in emergency settings, requiring rapid assessment and intervention. This session will explore:

1. Conservative vs. surgical management of severe hemorrhoidal bleeding and criteria for escalation of care.
2. Hemostatic techniques include compression, suture ligation, and coagulation strategies.
3. Collaborative decision-making between emergency physicians and colorectal surgeons for optimal patient outcomes.

Key Focus: Strategies for controlling severe rectal bleeding in acute care settings.
